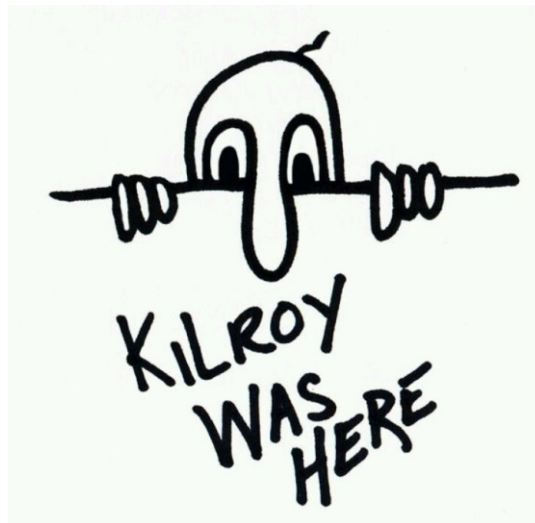

SI ADMINISTRATION: MEETING MINUTES by Erik Kunkle, Secretary

The April 7 meeting was held at Gates and Associates. President Bruce G. called the meeting to order at 1900L. 15 Members were present.

Treasurer Report (Bruce G.): As of 5 My 2026

-16 May Parade America and Car Show in Lake View Park, Nampa

Bruce G. briefed that as of now, no new information other than what was provided at the last meeting. The club will have a dedicated spot at the car show in Lake View Park. Expect more information to be sent out to the club the week prior to the event.

Craig D. briefed that he had found some information about the car show. The event is intended to add to Parade America and help it be a whole day event with a gathering in Lake View Park with an invite only car show, vendors, and a real family friendly atmosphere. The organizers are encouraging participants to have interaction with the children in attendance.

4- 6 June 3rd Annual IMVPA Car Show

Erik K. briefed that he would be recording the radio spot on 12 May at 107.1 HANK FM studios. He also briefed that HANK FM would like a recording of the club saying the Pledge of Allegiance before our meeting in order to work it into their 7 AM Pledge rotation. The club agreed, and the Pledge of Allegiance was recorded.

Craig D (Grill Master). briefed that it would cost around \$453 to provide food for the two days the grill will be opened. Plan to charge \$6 for a burger plate, \$5 for a hot dog plate. Only cooking for four hours on Friday and Saturday. The club could make a NET profit of roughly \$446 from the grill. Discussion then turned to condiments and drink types. Bruce is going to check with the Meridian Coca-Cola distributor for a donation of drinks and raffle prizes.

John D. (Lead Show Organizer) briefed that a general layout of how the show will be set up at Stark's has been accomplished and answered questions and touched on the highlights of the set up. He also briefed that Bishop Defense in Meridian paid for \$500 of the radio advertisement in exchange for being mentioned in the advertisement. He also briefed he has saved the club roughly \$1600 in expenses verses last year in donated porta potties, insurance cost, partial radio advertisement, and in printed flyers.

 **Military Phonetic Alphabets**

The military use of phonetic alphabets began in World War One with the advent of radio and telephonic technologies before the war and the need to improve spoken communication.

The alphabets shown to the right are/ were used by US forces from WWI to the present.

The top alphabet was used until 1956 while the lower alphabet was adopted in March of that year and is in common use by NATO countries today.

National Museum of Military Vehicles May 2026

The NMMV should be on your “must see” list. The collection includes US and other nation’s Mvs. The indoor displays are exceptionally well done. There is an impressive small arms display as well as uniforms and equipment. A flashlight is highly recommended for the Vietnam display. Take your time and carefully search the bamboo for cleverly done displays. Tanks, cars, motorcycles, jeeps, trucks of all sizes and eras populate the museum. The outdoor “overflow” area has many treasures such as a Xm151 MUTT, 17 US WWII halftracks, tanks, Dragon Wagons, and more MVs than you can shake a stick at. The museum is building another 140+ sq ft display building for it’s Cold War items and a 70 room hotel both of which will be next to the current museum. You can see everything in one day, if you move quickly, otherwise two days are recommended.

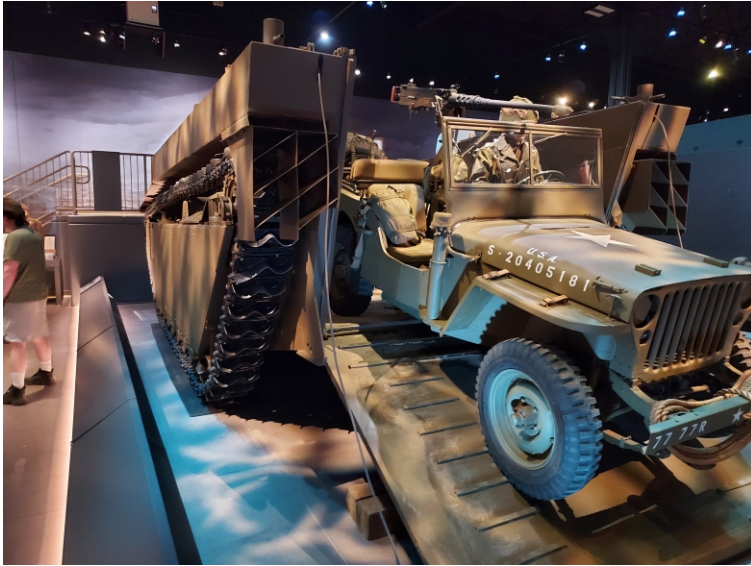
