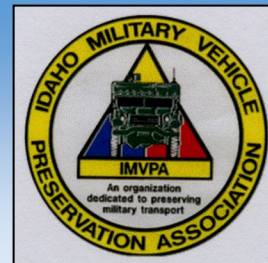

Tech time: SAVE THE SEATS

Tetraethyl lead was introduced into gasoline many years ago. It raised the octane rating of gasoline so engines could use a higher compression ratio to gain more horsepower. It also cushioned the valve seats when the intake and exhaust valves closed so the valve didn't destroy its seat. Our government decided lead was a harmful pollutant and forced most most gasolines to stop using lead. Now we have unleaded gasoline, which is fine for modern engines but not for our older engines. If your older engine was rebuilt the rebuilder may have added hardened valve seats or he may not have. If you don't have hardened valve seats you need to be using a lead substitute in your gas tank or you'll lose the valves and seats. On an overhead valve engine this means a valve job. On a flathead

engine this means a complete engine rebuild. You can find it at any auto parts store and it's usually about \$5 for a bottle that treats 20 gallons of gasoline.
