Strange Meat; an early Ben Hur by Pres Gates



Mike Breshears came up with an interesting Ben Hur made by Lavine. It must have been a prototype and appears to be NOS. The data tag says it's a ³/₄ ton Ben Hur instead of the normal 1 ton Ben Hur. The lunet is different, the fenders are different. The space between the tire and fenders is much smaller than on a standard Ben Hur. The wheels are different and marked as 1939 with smaller wheel studs. The measurement of the bed is still 4 X 8. The ebrake and landing gear are different than a standard Ben Hur.

David Doyle's Standard Catalog of Military Vehicles says the Ben Hur was not standardized until 1942 and it shows the only ³/₄ ton trailer made was a M101. It says all Ben Hurs are a 1 ton trailer.
